Job Duties and Description:

- Represent the management staff to translate words and written texts to Chinese and vice versa with superior accuracy, consistency and efficiency, for bridging the language barrier and facilitating cross-cultural communication with Chinese ethnicity customers and suppliers.
- Communicate in a friendly, positive and professional manner and always engage attentively to

 management staff, applying Chinese and American cultural knowledge to render an accurate and
 meaningful translation. Interact, coordinate, and liaise with Chinese ethnicity customers and
 suppliers to facilitate communication in various business and social settings to prevent
 misunderstanding and miscommunication by converting concepts in mandarin Chinese to equivalent
 concepts in English, and vice versa.
- Relay concepts and ideas between languages to management staff regarding cultural issues to Chinese ethnicity customers and suppliers. Relay the style and tone of the original language and render messages accurately, quickly, and clearly.
- Translate written messages, live chats and conversations, voice recordings and documents from Chinese into English and vice versa.
- Receive briefing or prepare through reading and study on subject to be discussed prior to translation. Identify terms and words with conflicting meanings to determine which alternative provides clarity and reflects the original purpose of the message.
- Verify, modify, edit and proofread text and message to accurately reflect language and compensate
 for discrepancies in technical terms and to guarantee that the final content is consistent with original
 material.
- Consult dictionaries, encyclopedias and terminology compilations to remain educated and current with the meaning of words and phrases.

A bachelor's degree in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) or Linguistics or the foreign degree is equivalent. Experience is not required.
